Abstract Submission Guidelines

To be considered eligible all abstracts must:

- Be unpublished original work and not previously presented
- The abstract must not be identical to any that has been previously published
- Be submitted in English

Categories for submission are:

- A. Case Reports
- B. Sports Science
- C. Surgical Management
- D. Rehabilitation
- E. Injury Prevention

When submitting your abstract please ensure:

- It is submitted in pdf format
- It is under the 400 word limit (excluding title)
- Ensure it contains the following headings:
 - Introduction should reflect a rationale / why you did this work. If applicable state the main purpose etc;
 - Methods should be a brief explanation of what was done and how it was done. This may include design, participants, data collection or a brief explanation of what you did or protocol used if a systematic review
 - Results describing the main findings or outcomes and include data. Do not submit an abstract based on data yet to be collected or analysed
 - Discussion defines what the results mean in terms of the background knowledge or practice. Compare and contrast with the current evidence or context
- Include a maximum of 4 references
- Abstracts will not be eligible if no results are presented
