



## Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine (RCPI & RCSI)

### Associate Membership Criteria –SPORT SCIENCES PATHWAY

- 1 Applicants must hold a sport sciences or exercise sciences degree from a recognised university,
- And
- 2 Must demonstrate satisfactory evidence of interest / involvement in Sports and Exercise Medicine,

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#### **Procedure for Application:**

The application form should be downloaded from the website, and it must be accompanied by:

- I. A cover letter,
- II. An up-to-date CV highlighting the applicant's area of expertise, as well as Sport and Exercise Medicine interest, and current (or future) involvement with the specialty (involvement with clubs, attendance at FSEM-related educational activities etc.), as well as referees' contact information,
- III. A notarised (\*) copy of the applicant's sport sciences or exercise sciences degree,
- IV. A notarised (\*) copy of the applicant's CORU registration certificate or Professional Regulatory Body registration certificate (or equivalent),
- V. And the application fee of €100

#### **Important – Please note:**

- Associate Members will be required to pay an annual fee to the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine to remain in good standing with the Faculty
- Associate Members have NO voting rights at Faculty Board Elections or Faculty AGM
- Associate Members may join Faculty Committees, upon prior invitation from the Committee Chairman only

(\*) Notarised copies - documents should be appropriately signed and stamped as a true copy of the original document, by a solicitor, a notary public, a justice of the peace, or a member of An Garda Síochána/Police Force.
