Associate Membership Criteria

- 1 Applicants must hold a basic primary medical or dental degree from a recognised university,
And
- 2 Must demonstrate satisfactory evidence of interest / involvement in Sports and Exercise Medicine,
And
- 3 Have the support from 2 Fellows of the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine (RCPI & RCSI)

Procedure for Application:

The application form should be downloaded from the website, and it must be accompanied by:

- I. An up-to-date CV highlighting the applicant's medical area of expertise, as well as Sport and Exercise Medicine interest, and current (or future) involvement with the Specialty
- II. A notarised (*) copy of the applicant's Medical / Dental degree
- III. Application form duly signed by 2 Fellows of the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine (RCPI & RCSI)
- IV. And the application fee of €100

Important – Please note:

- Associate Members will be required to pay an annual fee to the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine to remain in good standing with the Faculty
- Associate Members have NO voting rights at Faculty Board Elections or Faculty AGM
- Associate Members may join Faculty Committees, upon prior invitation from the Faculty Board & Committee Chairman only

(*) Notarised copies - documents should be appropriately signed and stamped as a true copy of the original document, by a solicitor, a notary public, a justice of the peace, or a member of An Garda Síochána.
